The Trans Tasman Cup competition will be held in New Zealand on 13th and 14th May 2006. The competition will be hosted by the Horowhenua Petanque Club in the town of Levin about 60 klms from Palmerston North on the North Island.

The National Team will consist of twelve players each, being six men and six women chosen from the top 12 in the men's and women's selection ranking at the end of the Easter Championships.

The Kiwis have also asked that we restrict our Seniors Team to the same numbers and make up, all of those people turning 60 and over this year [have been asked to contact Alan Irwin]. We can then work out a selection process that will be fair to all and ensure a happy team travels to New Zealand.
